



## **Bato, Gardi and Luigi Fabric Care Instructions**

It is important to look after the fabric to help maintain its appearance and condition. Most stains can be removed by wiping clean with a damp cloth. These fabrics **are not** machine washable. However, they are treated to be stain resistant and we are confident they will give long service, if properly looked after.

### **General Care:**

- Regular vacuuming to remove dust and fur
- Wipe minor soiling with a clean damp cloth, preferably a microfibre cloth, as provided.
- Stains may be removed using mild soap with warm water and sponging, rinse thoroughly followed by drying with an absorbent cloth, preferably microfibre. Full immersion or soaking of the cover is not recommended.
- All soap residue must be rinsed out of the fabric as it will attract further stains
- Mild antiseptic cleaning agents such as a solution of Dettol or similar can be used and more stubborn stains may require the use of a non ionic detergent (following manufacturer's instructions)
- Use cold water for stains produced by bodily fluids.
  
- **DO NOT MACHINE WASH**
- **DO NOT TUMBLE DRY.** Line or ainer dry, if necessary, iron on the face side of the fabric only at low temperature
- **DO NOT DRY CLEAN**

Please note that the longer stains are left untreated the more difficult they can become to remove.
