



## Nobel, Laurel and Sahel Fabric Care Instructions

It is important to look after the fabric to help maintain its appearance and condition. Most stains can be removed by wiping clean with a damp cloth. Although the fabric is machine washable, excessive washing will shorten its effective life by reducing the waterproofing and antibacterial properties. We suggest that you do not wash the cover more frequently than once a month and preferably less.

### General Care:

- Regular vacuuming to remove dust and fur
- Wipe minor soiling with a clean damp cloth, preferably a microfibre cloth as provided
- Stains may be removed using mild liquid detergent with warm water, rinse thoroughly followed by drying with an absorbent cloth, preferably microfibre.
- Use cold water for stains produced by bodily fluids.
- To remove other stains use proprietary products, following the instructions on the container carefully. Always pre-test cleaners on a hidden piece of fabric to evaluate the colourfastness and texture of the fabric before proceeding with cleaning.
- All soap residue must be rinsed out of the fabric as it will attract further stains

### Machine Wash:

- At 30°C delicate setting (low spin speed).
- Covers must **NOT** be turned inside out and the zips **MUST** be closed.
- Remove from machine as soon as washing cycle is complete. Some water will be retained inside the cover due to its waterproof characteristics and should be drained out immediately.
- **DO NOT TUMBLE DRY.** Line or ailer dry. If necessary, iron on the face side of the fabric only at low temperature
- **DO NOT DRY CLEAN**

Please note that the longer stains are left untreated the more difficult they can become to remove.
